Mr. Michael J. Johnson was born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. He is a Graduate of the United States Military Academy, West Point. Mr. Johnson is also a graduate of the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College and the Advanced Operational Studies War College Fellowship. He holds two master's degrees - one in Public Policy from the Monterey Institute of International Studies, Monterey, California, and one in Military Arts and Science, from the School of Advanced Military Studies, Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. As a Civilian leader he served six years as the Civilian Deputy for the Combined Arms Center – Training, five years as the Army University Deputy Provost, and currently serves as the Deputy Commandant of the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College.

Mr. Johnson's 26-year military career as an Armor officer includes assignments with 1st Armored Division, Bamberg, Germany; 4th Infantry Division, Fort Carson, CO; Defense Language Institute, Monterey, CA; Vienna Austria; 3rd Infantry Division, Fort Stewart, GA; Sinai Egypt; and the Combined Arms Center, Fort Leavenworth, KS. Three operational and four combat deployments include Operation Desert Storm; Operation Intrinsic Action Kuwait; Operation Joint Guardian Kosovo; Operation Iraqi Freedom I, III, V and Task Force Sinai/Multinational Force and Observers, Egypt.

Mr. Johnson has served in a variety of command and staff positions including Commander 3rd Squadron 7th U.S. Cavalry; ACOS G3, 3rd Infantry Division; Brigade Commander, Task Force Sinai; as well as Chief of Staff Multinational Force and Observers, and the Deputy for Combined Arms Center Leader Development and Education.
